PRIVACY STATEMENT

This statement describes what information the Association holds about you, what we use it for, how we look after it and explains the rights you have to access your information.

When a member joins the Association, we collect and retain in our Membership System your name, your contact details such as your address, phone numbers and email address. In addition, we record your beach hut number and keep a record of membership subscriptions paid to us. This information is updated from time to time.

You are asked if you are willing to provide this personal information and we regard this as you having given us consent to retain and use this information. Individual members have the right to have details of the data we hold about them.

The information you have given to the Association is principally used to contact you by telephone, e-mail or post with information of any damage or security risks to huts and any other matters that may be of interest to you as a member. Information is disseminated to members of the Association as necessary to enable the damage reporting system. Information on individual members will not be disclosed to any other organisation or individual. The information is held in a secure Membership System.

The Association has been advised by the Information Commissioner's Office that it does not need to register with it as a data controller. However, the Association will observe and operate within the General Data Protection Regulations.

The Association states that the information held is "lawful" and fully compliant with the Information Commissioner's Office General Data Protection Regulation 2018.
